Bidding Guidelines

Requirements for host country:

- Application should come from an EACS member
- Destination must be located in Europe
- Applicant must be linked to a respected university or scientific institution with a clear mission regarding education. An institution per se (University etc.) cannot apply for candidacy, only an individual can.

Proposals should include and describe the following:

- A formal letter of intent from the EACS member acknowledging their interest in bidding for the conference as the host country.
- A bid book containing the following information:
 - Presentation of the proposed destination
 - Presentation of the conference centre
 - Presentation of the accommodation capacity
 - Presentation of the accessibility
 - Misc. (support from government for social events, local speakers, transportation etc.)

Facts and Requirements:

- Number of expected participants: 3,500 to 4,000 delegates
- Best period for the conference: October
- Should start on a Wednesday and end on a Saturday (set-up of the exhibition/posters/registration counter on Tuesday or even Monday, depending on the structure of the conference facilities)

Conference Center Requirements:

| Main Plenary Hall | min. 2,800 persons |
|--------------------------|---|
| Additional session hall | min. 1,200 persons |
| 2 breakout rooms | (200) – 500 persons |
| 3 breakout rooms for MTP | Around 100 pax each |
| Min. 8 smaller rooms | max. 10-60 persons (for the organizers, hospitality suite, interview room, preview room, etc. |
| Poster exhibition | around 350 posters |
| Speaker preview room | 50 m ² |
| Press Conference room | around 80 persons |
| Exhibition space | 1,000 m ² net (should be close to the poster exhibition) |
| Catering area(s) | should be part of the exhibition or close to the exhibition) |
| Registration area | around 15-20 metres long counter with back office space |

Accommodation:

The city should offer at least 3,000 rooms mainly in the 5, 4 and 3 star Hotel category.

Accessibility:

The host city should have an airport with connections to major European cities and preferably with good intercontinental destinations.

Submission procedures:

- Proposals should be submitted (3) three years prior to the date of the conference
- 2. Interested EACS members must submit a letter of intent and a proposal:
 - No later than September 15, 2014 for the 16th European AIDS Conference/EACS in 2017



- 3. The proposal should not exceed 30 pages
- 4. Proposals are required to address all of the components stated above.
- Proposals must be received only in an electronic format (PDF or MS Word)
- 6. All bid applications will be screened for completeness prior to the evaluation
- 7. Incomplete applications may be returned to the applicant.

Useful information to consider including in the application:

- Make sure to include an evaluation of the costs of the conference centre in your proposal
- Average price in hotels of 5, 4, 3 stars category based on the year of the conference.
- Written commitments from government or any institution for additional funding or sponsorship of cocktail reception or free advertising in the city or transportation would be useful.
