BHIVA, DAIG, EACS, GESIDA & Polish Scientific AIDS Society Statement on risk of COVID-19 for people living with HIV (PLWH)

Case series of people living with HIV (PLWH) with COVID-19 have been published from China, Spain, Germany, Italy and the United States (1-15) with no clear evidence for a higher COVID-19 infection rate or different disease course in people with and without HIV. Of note, most case series of PLWH report a younger age in their study population than in HIV-negative hospitalised COVID-19 patients, but comparable rates of comorbidities.

Interview with Dr. Magdalena Ankiersztejn Bartczak on International Youth Day

On the occasion of the International Youth Day, which aims to raise awareness of challenges and problems facing the world's younger generations, the EACS secretariat interviewed Dr. Magdalena Ankiersztejn-Bartczak, a well-recognized HIV activist and PLWH advocate in Poland. She is the president of Foundation for Social Education (FES), an NGO Polish organisation which in addition to the HIV field, delivers education in numerous areas, such as sexual health, cancer prevention, and many others. Her background is in pedagogy, sexual education and sociology and she is the author and coordinator of numerous educational programmes delivering knowledge on HIV and fighting stigma and discrimination towards PLWH in Poland. Interview with EACS Vice President on World Hepatitis Day

On the occasion of World Hepatitis Day, whose aim is drawing attention to the global burden of viral hepatitis and to take action to reduce the number of undiagnosed cases, the European AIDS Clinical Society (EACS) secretariat interviewed its Vice President, Dr Sanjay Bhagani. He is a consultant physician in Infectious Diseases/HIV Medicine and General (internal) Medicine at the Royal Free Hospital in London with a special focus in the management of HIV inpatients with complex multi-system and opportunistic infections and patients with viral hepatitis coinfections. Dr Bhagani has an active interest in teaching doctors and post-graduates from resource-poor settings about managing HIV-associated opportunistic infections and viral hepatitis co-infections.

PentaTr@ining 2020: 'HIV & other Congenital Infections'

'PentaTr@ining is an interactive course that continues to develop and evolve in response to the changing needs of children living with HIV and other congenital infections. This year's online course, beginning on 2 November, will be highly interactive and clinical case-based, designed to kindle engagement and encourage intercommunication among the students and faculty team. It will consist of 6 weekly modules (about 90-120 minutes long), with associated pictures, infographics, tables and figures, references, and links to major PID websites of interest. EACS members can access the course at a discounted Early Bird rate before 25th September 2020.
