# Interview with Dr. Cristiana Oprea on the International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking

On the occasion of the International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, which aims to foster a global action to counter drug abuse, the EACS secretariat interviewed Dr. Cristiana Oprea, the Head of the HIV Department at Victor Babes Clinical Hospital for Infectious and Tropical Diseases in Bucharest, Romania. Dr. Cristiana Oprea's work is focused on HIV and opportunistic infections (tuberculosis and neurological complications), co-infections with viral hepatitis in people who inject drugs (PWIDs), and standards of care for HIV and co-infections in Eastern and Central Europe.

# Best practices in the management of women living with HIV- 18 & 22 July 2020

Recently, the United Conference of Hepatogastroenterology and Infectious Diseases (UCHID) and Kasr Al-Aini HIV and Viral Hepatitis Fighting Group have decided to go virtual for their medical education plans in 2020. The first topic "Women Living with HIV" was initially planned as one face-to-face scientific day earlier in March but based on the current situation it will be held as two separate virtual meetings on Saturday 18th & Wednesday 22nd of July 2020. The meetings will discuss recent medical recommendations for women living with HIV in limited-resources settings, social & economic challenges that women face, highlights from CROI & AIDS 2020, and also recent guidance for supporting women in the time of COVID-19 pandemic.

### **Meet EACS Vice President**



Sanjay Bhagani

Dr. **Sanjay Bhagani** is a **Consultant Physician** in Infectious Diseases/HIV Medicine at the Royal Free London Foundation Trust and an honorary Senior Lecturer in the Research Department of Infection at UCL, London. Born and brought up in Kenya, he went to Medical School in the UK and trained in Infectious Diseases and HIV Medicine in London.

He has a busy and varied clinical practice with a particular interest in the management of opportunistic infections, mycobacterial disease, viral hepatitis, and solid organ transplantation in HIV-infected patients. He leads a large multidisciplinary tertiary referral **HIV/hepatitis co-infection** service which is intricately linked to the regional viral hepatitis service and transplant centre.

He is the current **Chair** of the **BHIVA Hepatitis Committee** and has served on the anti-infective expert advisory group of the MHRA. He is also a current **member** of the **EACS HIV/hepatitis management guidelines committee** and the **BHIVA HIV/hepatitis guidelines group**. He has contributed to the BHIVA renal transplant guidelines in HIV-infected patients and the WHO European region guidelines on the management of HBV/HIV co-infection.
