EACS Young Investigators gather in Brussels for the YING Conference



The fifth YING Conference took place on 14-15 June, 2024 in Brussels, Belgium, bringing together a new generation of HIV experts from across the WHO European Region.

Organised by a dedicated scientific committee made up of YING members, the conference featured a series of engaging plenary sessions and workshops.

Participants explored a wide range of topics, including managing cardiovascular risk and implementing findings from the REPRIEVE Study. They also looked at low-level viraemia on ART as well as STI prevention. Finally, they discussed PROMs, quality of life and stigma, and breastfeeding transmission data and guidelines.

In addition to the plenary sessions, attendees participated in interactive workshops that focused on career development, looked at different study designs, as well as the cascade of care in Europe and how to improve it. The workshops also included brainstorming sessions on launching a bespoke medical service.


