### 17th European AIDS Conference - Save the date !

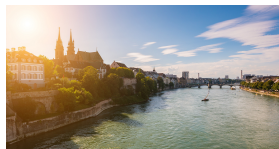
The next biennial European AIDS Conference will be organised in Basel from November 6-9, 2019.
