### Experts gather in Athens for the Standard of Care meeting



On 16-17 October, EACS held the biennial Standard of Care for HIV and Co-infections meeting in Athens, Greece. The aim of the meeting was developing a common standard of HIV clinical care throughout Europe.

EACS' decision to hold the 2024 meeting in Athens, Greece and to invite healthcare and community representatives from Türkiye and Greece to help organise it was timely. This region – the bridge between western and eastern worlds for millennia – has also become the world's hotspot for HIV in terms of new infections.

### 1 year until the 20th European AIDS Conference (#EACS2025) in Paris

We are excited to announce that the 20th European AIDS Conference (EACS 2025) will take place from 15-18 October 2025, in the iconic city of Paris. This marks a special occasion as we return to Paris, which last hosted the conference 33 years ago.

The city holds historical significance in the fight against HIV, having been the location where the first Declaration on Fast-Track Cities to End the HIV Epidemic was signed on World AIDS Day in 2014.

Under the theme, "**From Science to Implementation**," EACS 2025 will emphasise the importance of translating cutting-edge scientific advancements into effective solutions to the ongoing HIV epidemic, with the aim of ending AIDS by 2030.

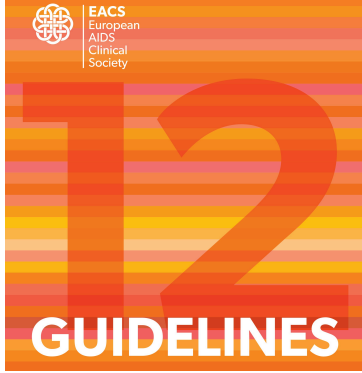
The survey will ask: your role in HIV care, your history of prescribing HIV care to migrants and your opinions on HIV care and prevention services for migrants.

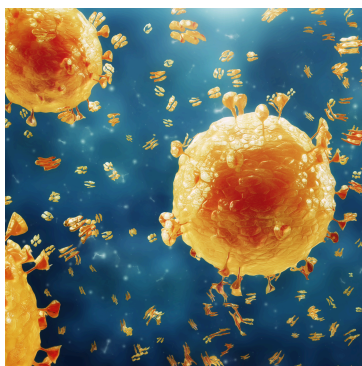
